What's happening at SDS this month:

- Halloween Fun Week: Oct. 27–30: Dancers may wear non-scary costumes to class!

 - \$50 = approx. half payment; balance + \$35 recital package due Nov. 13.
 - Performing/Competition company dancers have separate deposits due Oct., Nov., and Dec.
